In such are the guideposts of our loved ones journey into the future no matter the challenges faced. Beloved, the same is true for us as a church wed to our Saviour equipped and ready to serve him, each other and the world no matter what the future brings.

"Out of respect for Christ, be courteously reverent to one another. Wives, understand and support your husbands in ways that show your support for Christ. The husband provides leadership to his wife the way Christ does to his church, not by domineering but by cherishing. So just as the church submits to Christ as he exercises such leadership, wives should likewise submit to their husbands. (Ephesians 5:21-24 – The Message)

Minutes of the Stated Session Meeting

Sunday, August 5, 2012

6:00pm

The monthly stated meeting of the Session of Glade Spring Presbyterian Church was held at 6:00pm in the board room. The following members, constituting a quorum, were present: Dirk Wilmoth, Lee Brannon, Sonny Porterfield, Jay Robinson, Rebecca DeBusk, Steve Johnston, Clark Hutton, Michael Colston, Sara Hutton Tallman and Reverend Tim Bird, Moderator. Elders Patrick Buchanan and James Allison were excused.

Susan Henderson represented the deacons.

Reverend Bird called the meeting to order.

Steve Johnston gave a devotional from the book of Matthew and C.S. Lewis.

Reverend Bird offered a prayer.

Approval of Minutes

Two typographical errors and one amendment were noted.

MOTION: Steve Johnston moved, and Michael Colston seconded the motion, that the minutes of the stated meeting on June 3, 2012 were approved as amended and corrected and the minutes of congregational meeting on June 17, 2012 be approved as written. The motion passed.

MOTION: Clark Hutton moved, and Dirk Wilmoth seconded the motion, that the only persons authorized to sign checks for trust monies be Jay Robinson and James S. Hutton and all previous signatories be deleted. The motion passed.

Financial Report

Clark Hutton presented a financial report and noted that a Certificate of Deposit is about to mature. MOTION: Sonny Porterfield moved, and Dirk Wilmoth seconded the motion, that we leave the CD in the same account.

Clerk's Correspondence

The clerk presented the following correspondence: an application for use of the picnic shelter by Bonnie Ballinger for a family reunion on August 25th from 11:00am - 6:00pm; a letter from the Appalachian Center at Emory & Henry announcing daily delivery of meals for \$5.00 per meal.

MOTION: Steve Johnston moved, and Jay Robinson seconded the motion, that we hold the Sunday School/employee appreciation picnic on August 23 at 6:00pm prior to the Bible Study.

MOTION: Lee Brannon moved, and Rebecca DeBusk seconded the motion, to approve the use of the picnic shelter for Bonnie Ballinger.

Contact has been made with each person on the care list.

Minute for Minister

Reverend Bird reported that Glade Area Ministerial Association has been meeting on the first Wednesday of each month. Six churches are participating and are discussing ways to pool resources and work together on mission work. Reverend Bird will be moderator. Officers were elected. They will have monthly program.

Presbytery: The Abingdon Presbytery is operating without a transitional executive presbyter however, there is a stated clerk, Reverend Kevin Campbell from Hillsville Presbyterian Church. The Presbytery office building in Wytheville is for sale. The new office will be at Wytheville Presbyterian Church. It is the goal to be a paperless and virtual office.

Sarah Bird was accepted unanimously at the June 14 Presbytery meeting as a candidate.

Old Business

Reverend Bird reported the following: the minister's goal setting committee needs to meet; small group leaders are needed for the Bible Studies August-- Steve, Michael and Dirk volunteered; one more bid is needed for paving the parking lots; the new fence between the cemetery and the Robinson property has been completed.

New Business

The church has received an anonymous donation \$40,000. MOTION: Sonny Porterfield moved, and Dirk Wilmoth seconded the motion, that we place it in the Harry Price Fund and authorize Patrick Buchanan, Jay Robinson and Tom Hill to get the best bids possible for paving the parking lots up to \$85,000. The motion passed.

Sonny Porterfield reported that the books of the church have been audited for 2011 and stand in good order. This includes December 31, 2011 trustees' account and annual report.

Worship:

Rev. Bird reported that we have ordered samples of the new Presbyterian hymnal. MOTION: Rebecca DeBusk moved, and Michael Colston seconded the motion, to place samples in pew racks for review by the congregation.

The date for Homecoming is September 29.

MOTION: Rebecca DeBusk moved, and Lee Brannon seconded the motion that we purchase a choir robe for the choir director with a cost of less than \$200.00 and the funds will come from the session funds. The motion passed.

Personnel:

Steve Johnston reported that there is a need for nursery attendant and the application process has started.

Outreach:

New Providence Presbyterian Church from Rockbridge County came for one week again this summer to help rebuild a home for another tornado victim. They enjoyed lunch at the fellowship hall one day during the week. Saturdays in October are being reviewed to set a date for making apple butter.

A written report, our thanks and a check for \$10,000 has been returned to Presbyterian Disaster Assistance so the money can be used for other disasters. It is a requirement of the grant that any unspent funds be returned to PDA.

Property:

No meeting.

The committee met and discussed the nursery attendant position and creating a more infant-friendly nursery. Rally day is August 26.

Presbyterian Men:

The new tombstone has been installed in the cemetery at the burial site of unreadable headstones. Steve Johnston reported that there will be two plaques installed for the narthex and the new building.
